Calling the USDA Hotline at 1-866-348-6479 is another easy way to find free summer meals programs nearby.

- Hang posters in your cafeteria
- Talk to students in groups.
- Recruit teachers, school nurses, coaches and guidance counselors to spread awareness.
- Send home flyers and fact sheets to parents.
- Give your program a catchy name.
- Include a reminder on the agenda of PTA meetings.
- Work with recreation sites, community leaders or houses of worship to spread the word.
- Write a press release for local media.
- Reach out to local newspapers, TV stations, blog writers and others.
- Hang posters in nearby public locations
- Offer incentives/prize to students who bring a friend who is new to Summer Meals.
